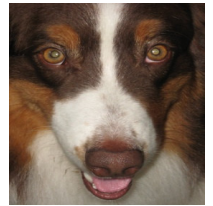

Held at a great private horse facility near Enumclaw, featuring several diverse indoor settings including large storage area, horse barn, hay storage area, and shop.

Nose work is a fun new sport that encourages your dog to use their amazing natural ability to detect odors and pinpoint the source. The sport was developed by professional detection work trainers, but instead of hunting for narcotics or lost people, the dogs learn to hunt for specific odors from essential oils. These two workshops focus on one of the four elements of searches, indoor area searches.



Desiree Snelleman has been involved in K9 Nose Work since its inception in 2006, as one of the first Certified Nose Work Instructors under the National Association of Canine Scent Work and as a competitor at the highest level. Her love of Nose work and working dogs has led her to teaching and conducting seminars to support handlers and dogs in this new sport.

In addition to Nose Work, Desiree and her two Siberian Huskies T'ai and Chi, along with her Border Collie Stinger also compete in Agility, Obedience and Rally. She has worked with all levels of dogs from beginners to champions. You can find more information at her website www.fidonfriends.com

These seminars are designed to provide information on setting up and performing indoor Nose Work searches. Desiree will use the variety of settings available at this one location to provide valuable feedback and to share her experience and insights on how to make searches fun, productive and safe for the dogs. The first session is for dogs that have already done some nose work and can do basic searches but are not yet solid on finding hides with Birch odor alone. The second session is for more experienced dogs able to find hides with Birch Odor.

“Indoor Hides with Birch Odor”
